

Aviation Survival Core Seminar

BWI's **Aviation Survival Core Seminar (ASCS)** is a specialized response to the wilderness survival needs of modern aircrew and regular passengers who travel into remote areas of Canada's Wilderness. Our Aviation Survival training is a well-researched and documented introduction to modern aviation survival. It teaches and updates your knowledge, providing contemporary information on the concepts you need to survive while stranded in the wilderness after an aviation accident.

The course covers survival physiology, clothing, fire lighting, shelter building, modern emergency signals, aviation survival equipment, and preparation. Transport Canada regulation will be discussed and analyzed.

In the Aviation Survival Core Seminar we will deal with how to **mentally prepare yourself for surviving in the wilderness** and how to handle your passengers during this crisis. Let's face it once you are on the ground you are in the same position as every other person; how you have prepared, and what you know about wilderness survival is what will save you on the ground. We will discuss and analyze typical aviation and non-aviation survival episodes. The Search and Rescue system in Canada will also be discussed.

Each section of the ASCS will be highlighted with a display and an extensive reading list will be provided along with Transport Canada regulations for survival equipment in all regions of Canada. This course is based on Wilderness Survival Core Seminar and is given equivalency for the BWI's Survival Certificate or other Modern Survival Training & Courses.
