

# Wilderness Survival Winter Field Training

*Do you have the skills to travel through the rugged Boreal Forest?  
Are you willing to learn new skills, knowledge, and gain experience?*

The Wilderness Survival Winter Field Training is designed to be both an adventure and an educational experience that will let you see the true challenges of survival in winter. Instruction will be ongoing during the training and you will be learning constantly.

Boreal Wilderness Institute's Wilderness Survival Winter Field Training is a journey through the boreal forest, where participants have a chance to really discover the winter forest and its many resources. This course is 3-days of training in the boreal forest starting off where the Wilderness Survival Winter Field Session left off.

It is designed to be a continuous learning experience where you will be challenged as you travel through the winter boreal environment. Instruction will be ongoing during the trip and you will be learning as you travel.

This course allows you to take the next step by integrating survival and wilderness living skills with wilderness travel skills. Participants will earn BWI's Survival Certificate on successful completion of this course and its prerequisites.



**Course Information:** Cost includes instruction, extensive course materials, use of various materials shelters, and tools. Food, Personal Gear, Winter Boots, and Winter Clothing are NOT provided, please read the **WSWFT Equipment List** and ask questions before you arrive to avoid problems. Transportation to the start point and or movement between camps (if conditions warrant) are not included in the price.

Locations change each year and vary depending on snow conditions, weather, location availability, and fire bans, etc.
