

## **Bear Safety Training [BST]**

This instructor-led 3.5-hour bear safety training course teaches safe wilderness travel, bear awareness strategies and tactics to help survive a bear encounter. This course is designed to help prevent fatal bear/human encounters. It emphasises in-depth practical knowledge of grizzly and black bear behavior. It also covers Polar Bears and Grizzly-Polar Bear Hybrids.

This highly educational training covers how to mitigate Bear encounters and worksite interactions. Bear awareness strategies and tactics to help you survive a bear encounter are emphasized. This includes coexistence strategy with various types of bears including mother and cub encounters.

On the **BST** we teach you the safe use of wildlife deterrents including bear spray & bear bangers. We teach both how to reduce deadly encounters and the unnecessary destruction of bears. We study safe practices, bear behaviour, bear sign, and dealing with problem bears.

This course includes a hands-on demonstration with a Bear Spray canister to allow practice in safe employment and handling. The **BST** always has a hands-on practice session where all participants get to practice using inert bear spray.
